Prayer Focus during Holy Week:

Tuesday: The Priest is not a priest for himself, but for you: These are the words of St. John Vianney, the patron saint of Parish Priests. Please, pray for the Bishop, all our priests and clergy, especially on Tuesday as you and them attend the Chrism Mass and renew their priestly promises. Also pray for vocations to the priesthood and the diaconate for the harvest is rich and the labourers are few! Many are retiring and too few are replacing them! Mass: 11am at the Cathedral

Holy Thursday: From the Washing of the Feet and Institution of the Blessed Sacrament, let us join with Christ at Gethsemane to pray for unity in our Church and world which is being divided by segregation in different forms and the unquenchable thirst to become rich: Mass at 8pm followed by Eucharistic Adoration till midnight at the Annunciation.

Good Friday: Journey with Christ to Calvary, we need to pray for ourselves, to develop that spirit of selfless love in answer to Christ teaching: Greater love hath no one that to lay down his life for his friends. This is the only love that can save our families, society, country and the world. Stations of the Cross at 10am with Confessions at Edmund Campion and Good Friday Service at 3pm at the Annunciation. **Good Friday Collection:** May I remind you that it is customary (& mandated by the Holy See) for the collection taken at Good Friday's Liturgy of the Lord's Passion, to be for the care of the Holy Places.

Holy Saturday: Celebrating with those who will be newly initiated into our faith in baptism, confirmation and Holy Communion, could we pray for the gift to remain a light to the world in relation to what it means to be human and image God. Through us, may God bring into the world a new humanity. Services begin at 8.30pm at the garden by the Hall in the Annunciation.
