Holy Week

On this Palm Sunday as we walk together in procession we walk in willingness to enter into the mystery of the cross and resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ; the atmosphere is charged with both expectation and contradiction, with joy and with soberness. The first Gospel reading presents two very different scenes leading to salvation – with cloaks spread out in the road (palms in the other Evangelists accounts) radiate confidence and excitement as the whole group shout out for joy. And the Passion Gospel (from St Luke) proclaims false confidence, reticence, humiliation and scorn. This is why we need to be part of all the chapters of Holy Week – to walk with Jesus through the Last Supper, His trial, suffering and crucifixion, and then on Easter Morning we can truly celebrate the risen Christ, risen from the dead to reign forever. As Bishop Robert Barron says 'Jesus transforms human life and makes that transformation available to us, through His Church, feeding us with His life-giving Body and Blood'. Jesus taught His disciples about true-discipleship at the Last Supper – may we also go out and be true missionary disciples every day of our lives.
